Battery capacity limits dictate how power banks can be used on European flights. Power banks with a capacity up to 100 watt-hours (Wh) are generally permitted in carry-on luggage. According to the EASA regulations, devices between 100 Wh and 160 Wh require prior approval from the airline.

Can you carry a power bank on a plane?

Carry-on Only: Power banks must be packed in carry-on luggage; they are not allowed in checked bags due to fire risks. Capacity Limits: The maximum capacity allowed is 100Wh (Watt-hours) per power bank without airline approval. Some airlines may allow up to 160Wh with prior permission.
