Why did SLA design Copenhill?

Danish landscape architects SLA designed the rooftop greenery, which doubles as a natural filter for air pollutants and a solution for stormwater runoff, thereby enriching the building's environmental contributions. The design of CopenHill is a study in juxtaposition, where function and form converge.
