Does the Gambia have 5G?

Currently, none of the network operators in the Gambia are providing 5G services. Africell and QCELL are the only network operators currently providing 4G coverage and are both focused on expanding their 4G network nationwide. Internet connectivity into The Gambia is managed by Gamtel, with bandwidth sold to other ISPs.

How many mobile network operators are there in the Gambia?

There are four mobile network operators (MNOs) in The Gambian market: GAMCEL (State Owned), AFRICELL (foreign investor-owned), COMIUM (foreign investor-owned) and QCELL (owned by a Gambian). The total number of Active subscribers in the Gambia as of December 2020 is approximately 2.7 million subscribers.
