Why does Wyze base station fail setup?

Wyze Base Station is connected to your network, but fails setup. Make sure you have the latest version of the Wyze app. If using a VPN on your network, please disable it for the duration of the setup process. Make sure you're interacting with the right Base Station if you have more than one.

How do I move a base station to a different access point?

After the Base Station is set up, it can be moved to one of the access points. Check that local permissions are enabled for the Wyze app. You can check this in your device's settings. The base station has power. Your network has an internet connection and your device is connected to a 2.4 GHz network.

Why is my TP-Link outdoor access point not working?

Background Many users will use TP-Link Outdoor Access Points together with Ubiquiti (UBNT) access point. Some users may encounter problems when trying to connect the TP-Link Outdoor Access Points to the UBNT access point. Most of these problems are caused by mismatched settings.

How do I know if my base station is working?

Make sure you're interacting with the right Base Station if you have more than one. Verify the status light color to make sure the Base Station is set up and functional. It should be solid blue. Once the status light is solid blue, try the setup process again. If the status light never changes to solid blue, try another Ethernet cable if possible.
