Where can I find Portugal tiles?

To find amazing Portugal tiles, you should visit the São Bento Railway Station. Built in 1903, this place incorporates more than 20,000 tiles that depict certain events from Portugal's history. Another great place to find these tiles is the Church of São Francisco in Porto.

How much does a Portuguese tile cost?

You'll find affordable tiles here (around 15-25 euros apiece) as well as some considerably more expensive options - many tiles are centuries old and just gorgeous, and you can only expect to pay a fair price to take a piece of Portuguese history home with you.
